We can't lie. We're a little teary as we write this.


Exciting times lie ahead. But for now, raise a stack cup, grab a mate, toast the good times, and help us give our old pal Leopallooza one last, epic send off.




THE LEOPALLOOZA 'PLEASE BE LOVELY' GUIDELINES

- No glass. Glass isn't allowed anywhere at The Wyldes it's very bad for the bare feet, tyres, and wildlife who call the fields home after you leave.
- Personal alcohol: weekend campers aged 18 and over may bring alcohol into the campsites. Each person may bring 24 cans of beer/cider/ premixed spirit cans OR 3 litres of wine. No straight spirits.
- No personal alcohol in the main arenas or Palloozaville.
- No drugs. We have a zero-tolerance policy towards drugs. If you are caught using or in possession of illegal drugs or legal highs including nitrous oxide (NOS) along with associated items including, but not limited to, balloons, CO2 dispensers, and whipped cream dispensers, our friendly but firm security team will immediately ask you to leave the site.
- Know your fire exits! See the map in this programme to find your closest.
- We have a zero-tolerance policy on homophobic, transphobic and racial hate. We are proud to be an inclusive venue and if anyone is caught being verbally or physically abusive, they'll be escorted off our site.
- No pets of any kind. As much as we love furry friends here (we really, really do) we're afraid they're not allowed anywhere on site. It's a licence thing. (If you require a guide dog please drop us a line)
- Camping: please be considerate of your neighbours. They're either friends, or friends you haven't met yet. Love them like your own.
- Gas camping stoves are allowed, but please use safely. Never cook inside your tent, and always share your sausages.
- Disposable BBQs, coal BBQs and fires are not allowed.
- Look 25: our bars run a strict Look 25 policy. The baby-faced amongst you will need to bring some ID with you.
- Wristband: this is the most important bit of jewellery you will ever wear! Don't lose it, or you will risk having to buy another to get anywhere.
- We run a landfill-free site, which requires your help. There are bins all around the site, which we thoroughly sort. 90% of our waste is recycled with the remaining 10% made into fuel pellets. Please use those bins.
- Our neighbours generously allow this party to happen, and we're really grateful! Please be considerate, drive sensibly and keep noise to a minimum after hours.
- Valuables: we find lost keys, wallets, phones, and the occasional bemused hippy every year. Keep your valuables somewhere safe. And should you lose something, speak to security or head to the merch store in Palloozaville.
- No bad attitudes. We've won awards for being a friendly and welcoming festival... we're proud of that. And so should you be. Well done!
- Please leave by Monday, 2pm. The deer and hares want their home back!

But now we're heading down a new, exciting, unmarked track. It's big, it's bold, and we'll be sharing more news very soon. But most importantly there's room for all of you to jump in for the ride.

As we draw the curtain for the very last time, we want to throw out the biggest thank you to the thousands of you who have supported this event over the years - all the OGs and the New-Gs, the buskers and the boujies, the rockers, the ravers, the phone and flag wavers, the moshers and moonwalkers, the slightly creepy band stalkers, the cosmic adventurers, and the smurfs who recycle the empty tents for us...heck, even all you beautiful and terribly misunderstood poi fans: all of you who have joined us for this incredible ride at any point within the last 18 years - we bloody love you. Always have, and always will.
